Level 2 Instructors work with their council's Outdoor Ethics Advocate to provide Leave No Trace Level 1 Instructor training, Scouting America Leave No Trace Basics and other outdoor ethics awareness training. The course includes in depth discussions of the Seven Principles of Leave No Trace as they apply in Scouting and various outdoor recreation activities, including both frontcountry and backcountry environments.

Each participant will present a Leave No Trace topic and activity to the group, and receive and provide feedback on presentation techniques, and participate in activities for teaching about Leave No Trace.

We will be staying in a traditional Scout camp site, preparing meals together using a variety of techniques, and hiking in the camp and adjacent Blue Hills Reservation.
