Bear:

Leave What you find
Be Kind to Other visitors

Implied:

Know before you go – personal and group camping gear
Trash your Trash – plan a meal, shop, preparing and cooking food
Choose the right path – hike right, setup tent
Respect Wildlife – Id plants

take a hike (trash your trash) 6 essentials , plan for weather , find plants or animals,

Wolves:

Adventure: Call of the Wild

attend an outdoor activity or campout (be careful with fire)

6 essentials, id 4 animals, plan gear for weather, clean up site /pickup gear

Adventure: Paws on the Path:

Take a hike: (Respect Wildlife)

Plan the route, enjoy it quietly, observe wildlife, pack out what you find

Bears:

Adventure: Bear Necessities

Camp overnight: 6 essentials, group gear, plan, help cook meal and clean , pick a spot and help set up tent, pick up camp site

Fur Feathers and Ferns: Be considerate in the Outdoors/leave what you find/Be kind to Other Visitors

While hiking 1 mile, ID 6 signs of plants and animals, 6 essentials, choose the right path, LWUF, Quiet
